Project Description:

Kampung Akuarium was forcibly evicted by the DKI Jakarta Provincial Government on April 11 2016 for unknown reason. Through various advocacy, organizing and other tactics, the residents of Kampung Akuarium together with the Rujak Center for Urban Studies, the Jakarta City Poor People's Network and the Urban Poor Consortium succeeded in pushing for the redevelopment of Kampung Akuarium on the same site.

The redevelopment uses co-design principles with designs that suit the needs of residents and adopt the unique economic activities. The 2 blocks of Kampung Susun Aquarium were completed in August 2021, and 2 blocks finalized in April 2023. The construction uses funds from the infrastructure levy, supervised by residents. The building is managed by the housing co-op that was set up by the Kampung Akuarium residents.
